Through key partnerships, we provide a range of services, support and resources for all volunteer involving organisations and just under a million volunteers, which contributes to positive volunteering experiences and the strengthening of communities.

We are pleased to see an increase in brand awareness and recognition for our organisation in both the Northern Territory and South Australia. Website hits have increased by over 64,000 over the last year which can be credited to a range of initiatives and promotional strategies. The WeDo App promotion during National Volunteer Week saw footpath stickers throughout Adelaide's CBD and banners in Victoria Square. The annual NVW Parade continues to grow with over 1000 registrations. For six years, the NT Volunteer of the Year Awards have recognised volunteers, volunteer managers and organisations for their outstanding contribution, further increasing the profile of the volunteering sector in the Northern Territory.

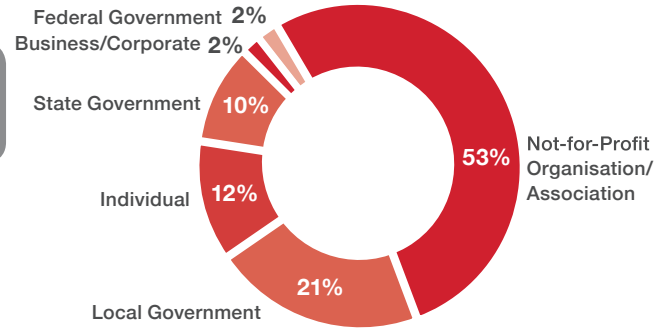

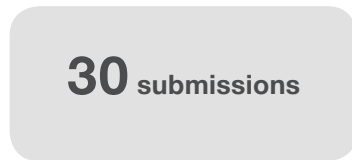
